To start with, we purchased the building next door and have expanded our Polish Pottery line into the adjoining space. This allows us to devote all of our original space to our Arts & Crafts collections.




In order to expand our Frank Lloyd Wright Collection, we have created a Frank Lloyd Wright Room with many new and unusual items, with more arriving on a regular basis. These are perfect gifts for architects, designers, or the FLW fan: books, journals, framed prints, pillows and throws, clocks, candles, even umbrellas!

RENDITIONS CLASSES

In each class, learn the basic techniques of a new art and apply that knowledge to complete a project ready to take home.

March 7, 1-3pm ~ *Pillow Talk*

Learn stenciling techniques to stencil a decorative pillow with a word and designs. Fabric, stuffing, stencil, mini paint set, set of 4 brushes, instructions included. \$40

March 14, 1-5pm ~ *Leaded Glass*

Assemble a beveled glass panel using lead came. All supplies included, tools provided. \$95

March 14, 5-7pm ~ *Take Note*

Learn stenciling techniques to stencil a set of 6 handmade paper note cards. Six cards and envelopes, set of 3 stencils, mini paint set, set of 4 brushes, instructions included. \$35

March 21, 1-4pm ~ *Stenciling Placemats & Napkins* Using basic and advanced stenciling techniques, stencil a set of four placemats and matching napkins. Placemats, napkins, set of 4 brushes, instructions included. Purchase stencil and paints at beginning of class. \$45

March 28, 1-3pm ~ *Stenciling Frameable Art*

Learn stenciling techniques to stencil a frameable piece of art on handmade paper and linen. Handmade paper, linen, stencils, mini paint set, set of 4 brushes, instructions included. \$40

April 4, 1-5pm ~ *Stenciling & Embroidery*

Stencil a large decorative pillow and embellish the design with embroidery. Fabric, stuffing, stencil, mini paint set, set of 4 brushes, embroidery floss, needle, instructions included. \$60

April 11, 5-7pm ~ *Pillow Talk* \$40

April 18, 1-3pm ~ *Stenciling Tea Towels*

Learn stenciling techniques to stencil a set of 4 tea towels with a monochrome design and a multi-colored design. Four tea towels, stencils, mini paint set, set of 4 brushes, instructions included. \$40

April 18, 1-5pm ~ *Leaded Glass* \$95

April 25, 1-3pm ~ *Take Note* \$35
